## **To whom it may concern**

**Regarding the M2G boiler load compensating control and Fermoy Leisure Centre**

Fermoy Leisure Centre is a Town Council managed Leisure Centre which serves the town of Fermoy in North County Cork and its hinterland. The centre comprises a 25-m swimming pool, kiddie's pool and steam room.

Fermoy Leisure Centre was awarded the prestigious 'white flag' award for excellence in 2003, 2004 and 2005 from the Institute of Leisure and Amenity Management Ireland (ILAM)

In February 2003 we installed a Micro-save M2G load compensating boiler control supplied by GEM Ltd. This boiler supplies all the heating and hot water supply to the building. Our Leisure centre is Building Energy Management controlled by Cylon Systems.

The savings produced were calculated at 13% - 15% of our annual fuel consumption. This calculation was based on oil meter readings taken each day by leisure centre staff.

We have not had to conduct any setting, calibration or commissioning of the M2G control since installation and it has not required any repair or maintenance.
